A new Pittsburgh-based sailing program offered by area sailors

MISSION

The Point of Pittsburgh Sailing League provides a safe, fun and structured program to learn how to sail that includes STEM education principles. This co-educational program is open to high school students (age 14 and above) in the greater Pittsburgh area with a targeted effort to engage students in the Pittsburgh Public School District.

SAFETY*

Sailing instruction is provided by certified sailing instructors using the US Sailing Association learn-to-sail program. A safety boat will be on the water with students at all times. Additionally, our safety protocols, which include the wearing of life jackets, have been reviewed by the US Coast Guard and other stakeholders.

LOCATION

The sailing program operates from the amphitheater located between Heinz Field and the Carnegie Science Center. Sailing will be on the Allegheny River near the Point of Pittsburgh.

RACING

In addition to offering an opportunity to learn how to sail, the sailing program will include both local and regional interscholastic racing opportunities. High school sailing programs are offered in many other areas including Philadelphia, Boston and Washington DC.

- ▶ No background or experience in sailing required
- ▶ Swimming certification *will* be required
- ▶ Access to a fleet of RS Quest sailboats and safety equipment is included in program fees

- ▶ Preseason classes begin in May
